An apprenticeship is a hands-on way to learn new skills while earning a salary, allowing you to avoid student debt and start earning right away.

It offers a fast track route to a career, equipping you with in-demand skills that employers value.

Apprenticeships typically last between two to five years, depending on the level and the complexity of the role with time split between learning in a classroom and working with a company.

They are available at various levels, from intermediate (Level 2) to degree apprenticeships (Level 6), where you can achieve a university-equivalent qualification without full-time study.

During your apprenticeship, you will be mentored by experienced professionals and have the chance to work on real projects that make a tangible difference.
